Airtel will take over Telenor India's spectrum, licenses and operations, including its employees and customer base of 44 million With 7 circles of Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Uttar Prades (East and West) and Assam with employees of approx 800, a famous Norwegian Telecom operator Teleno would be bought by Bharati Airtel. Less than a month after Vodafone confirmed it was in talks with ide cellular for a possible merger in India which could create the country's largest mobile operator, India based Airtel has come up with this sparkling news. This deal will help India's largest telecom service provider to widen its lead over Mukesh Ambani-led Reliance Jio, which has already notched up 10 million users, where Vodafone and Idea to successfully conclude a merger, the combined entity woul have almost 400 million users. "Bharti Airtel has entered into a definitive agreement with Telenor Sout Asia Investments Pvt. Ltd. To acquire Telenor India", Bharti said in a statement. "It will also enable Airte to further bolster its strong spectrum footprint in these seven circles, with the addition of 43.4 MH spectrum in the 1800 MHz band" it said. Though the companies didn't disclose the deal size, a Deutsch Bank Market Research report pegged the value of the transaction at about 300 million or more than 2,00 crore. Bharti Airtel shares gained 1.4% on the BSE to close at 366.05 on 23rd Feb 2017.
